Please describe a summary of work undertaken by the SAC to improve student achievement and school performance.

During the 2026-2027 school year, the SAC committee continued to support student achievement and school performance by approving spending to support our literacy, math, and well-being goals.

At the beginning of the year, the committee had all positions filled for the first time in several years. Unfortunately, one community member was unable to commit after the year started. A new member was not found during the school year, but an active search will continue for the fall.

The principal and chair attended the SAC conference in November. They shared their experience and what they learned in each session with the other SAC members. The highlight for both members was the networking with people from other regions.

Members approved a variety of requests to assist with our SSP and student achievement. Two notable expenses were purchasing new classroom tables for one of our primary/grade 1 classrooms and buying more decodable books for the lower elementary classes. The tables were to replace larger tables that were not the correct size for the classroom. The decodable

books will support teachers with reading and word work programming. They were the same books rolled out earlier this year. Each lower elementary classroom will now have their own set of books.
